



Health & Safety Pre-Travel To-Do List for The Bahamas

VACCINATED TRAVELERS

✓ **Important Date:** **Sunday, July 4, 2021**

Apply for a Bahamas Travel Health Visa at travel.gov.bs and **upload proof of vaccination** (such a CDC or government-issued vaccine record card) confirming you have passed the two-week immunity period. The name and date of vaccination(s) must be clearly stated in order to complete the application and presented upon arrival in The Bahamas. *Please note, there is a \$40 per person non-refundable fee that is reimbursable for you and your guest (\$80 total) through Konica Minolta's Expense Report system, Concur, located on MyKonicaMinolta.com.*

NOTE: Although The Bahamas does not require a negative COVID-19 test for vaccinated travelers, Konica Minolta strongly suggests a PCR Test be performed prior to traveling.

UNVACCINATED TRAVELERS

✓ **Important Date:** **Saturday, July 3, 2021**

Each unvaccinated winner and their guest (if unvaccinated) must take a PCR test on July 3, 2021. **This test cannot be taken any earlier than July 3** as The Bahamas Government states that it cannot be taken more than 5 days prior to travel. You will be leaving the U.S. for departure to The Bahamas on Wednesday, July 7.

✓ **Important Date:** **Sunday, July 4, 2021**

Apply for a Bahamas Travel Health Visa at travel.gov.bs and **upload your negative COVID-19 PCR test results** in order to complete the application and present it upon arrival in The Bahamas. *Please note, there is a \$40 per person non-refundable fee that is reimbursable (\$80 total) through Konica Minolta's Expense Report system, Concur, located on MyKonicaMinolta.com.*

NOTE: If you are extending your trip, there is a \$60 (non-refundable) fee for U.S. & Canadian citizens **unvaccinated and staying for more than four (4) nights and five (5) days**; all other countries there is a \$70 (non-refundable) fee for the same stay period. You may expense up to \$80 total.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE BAHAMAS TRAVEL HEALTH VISA FOR ALL PEOPLE (VACCINATED AND UNVACCINATED)

All travelers **must apply for a Bahamas Travel Health Visa** at travel.gov.bs and complete the application for approval to present upon arrival in The Bahamas. The name of the applicant must exactly match name on the applicant's valid passport.

- As part of the Bahamas Travel Health Visa application, all travelers – vaccinated and unvaccinated – will be **required to opt-in to COVID-19 health insurance that covers them for the duration of their stay in The Bahamas.**

- The \$40 per person health visa application fee, which includes the cost of the required COVID-19 health insurance, is reimbursable (\$80 total) through Konica Minolta's Expense Report system, Concur, located on MyKonicaMinolta.com.
- Bahamas Travel Health Visa applications take up to **48 hours to process** and should be completed **by the above deadline date of Sunday, July 4.**
 - Green: Approved Health Visa (must present confirmation upon arrival)
 - Yellow: Pending Health Visa (application requires additional review)
 - Red: Denied Health Visa (entry not permitted)
- **Once approved, please carry both a printed copy of the Bahamas Travel Health Visa and place a copy on your mobile device**, as you will be required to show it at airline check-in in order to be granted travel to Nassau, Bahamas.
